

What is the Cost?

We want to help you understand how much services at Eskenazi Health cost. There is a lot of information if you need help please call Eskenazi Health at 1.855.202.1053.

Here are a few things you need to know:

- No one pays for a COVID-19 test during the Public Health Emergency. When the Public Health Emergency ends the cost will increase.
- Eskenazi Health contracts with payors who have different rates for services.
- Your cost will depend on your insurance coverage.
- If you don't have insurance an Eskenazi Health financial counselor can help you look for coverage.
- Out of Network means the insurance company is not contracted with Eskenazi Health. You might be responsible to pay more for the services.
- You received a list of insurance companies. If the Medical box says yes, Eskenazi Health is contracted. If it says no we are not contracted.
- If the Behavioral Health Box says Yes, Eskenazi health is contracted. If it says no we are not.
- There are two terms you may not understand Hospital and Shoppable.
 - Hospital shows the largest and smallest amount insurance will pay.
 - Shoppable shows the largest and smallest amount for services that happen every day. This may be called "common" service.
- Hospital charges Negotiated shows how much each insurance company pays.
- Inpatient stay shows the most an inpatient stay will cost **BEFORE** Insurance is added.
- Inpatient Pharmacy Charges lists largest price for medicine **BEFORE** Insurance is added.
- Supply Charges lists the largest price for a supply **BEFORE** insurance is added.
- Professional Charges show the largest and smallest amount **BEFORE** insurance for Eskenazi Health doctor charges.
- Some doctors are employed by IU Health. The prices for their services are set by IU Health.
- With two employer groups for the doctors it is easiest to call us for the estimate.
